General Cost Information:

Please note - not all costs will be applicable to every program

- Tuition:** Base cost for each credit a student is enrolled in, based on residency (ND Resident, MN Reciprocity, U.S. Resident, International). For tuition/fee rates and residency applications, visit [NDSCS.edu/Costs](https://www.ndscs.edu/Costs).
MN Residents: to receive the the MN Reciprocity rate, you must apply & be approved each academic year.
- Per-Credit Fees:** ConnectND, NDSA, Student and Technology. Fees shown are based on the primary location selected for this estimate (Wahpeton, Fargo, or Online); actual costs will be calculated based on the location of each class enrolled in. (ConnectND, NDSA, Student and Technology fees cap at 12 credits per semester.)
- Instructional Fees:** Charged per credit and calculated based on the prefixes of the classes a student is enrolled in. (Instructional fees do not cap at 12 credits.)
- Online Access Fee:** \$38.00/credit for classes taken online. (Online Access fees do not cap at 12 credits.)
- Tools:** Program-specific required tools, tool boxes, instruments and safety equipment. For more information, visit [NDSCSBookstore.com](https://www.ndscs.edu/Bookstore).
- Laptop/Tablet:** Program-specific required computer, tablet or specific hardware/software. For more information, visit [NDSCS.edu/ITS](https://www.ndscs.edu/ITS).
